In the coming year our technical panels will engage some work around creating and updating already existing guidance documents. Such as MfS, Providing for Journeys on foot, planning and sustainable transport.

Our work on Shared Space has neared completion and publication should be soon, likewise our work at creating a bus guideline document is progressing well and is at almost complete.

A small working group has been established to take forward the recommendations from CIHT FUTURES. I will share the final document in due course.
